

GRADES:

This section is designed to measure the candidate's scholastic achievement. Grades will include a maximum of 10 grades for the 7th grade year and five grades for 8th grade year. (*) Please note- all CORE classes (English, Math, Science, Social Studies and Foreign Language) must be included before non-academic grades can be used.

Students who complete HONORS classes may substitute up to *four grades for their 7^{th} grade year and *two grades for their 8^{th} grade year for core classes.

A copy of the student transcript must be included with the application.
